

Examples of four designs used by Brunel in Cornwall are shown on the right. earlier surprisingly thev had larger spans and taller his structures in the Stroud area. The Cornish viaducts were almost all single track whereas the in the Stroud Valley were all double track. The ones Cornwall and South Devon railways had West in total 65 timber viaducts of which 52 of these occurred in a total length of just 68 miles in The total length of the 52 viaducts was almost 6 miles and several were more than 1000ft in length.
