

George Inn Throud 13th September

We the undersigned Commissioners having met at the above place pursuant to advertisement for that purpose do hereby judge that the Thames & Severn Canal Company shall pay to Mr Daniel Capel for one acre two roods and twenty one Perches of land belonging to the said Daniel Capel in certain Meads in the colled Mansels Meads two orchards and a garden in the parish of Throud the sum of One hundred and forty six pounds fifteen Shillings and three pence, the same being purchased at £3 above & thirty years purchase, the Co paying Taxes -

We also adjudge that the said Company shall pay to the said Dan Capel the sum of forty seven Pounds ^{Shillings} Twelve, for the Interest of the said sum of £146. 15. 3 - from the time the Company entered thereon viz the 12th Day of October 1783 to this Day -

We also adjudge that the said Company shall pay to the said Dan Capel the sum of one hundred and sixty nine pounds in lieu of satisfaction ^{at least} of Damages as the said Dan Capel has ~~and~~ sustained or which he his Heirs or Assigns may sustain in the Land or any part thereof by means of the said Canal or any of the Works belonging

thereto -

We also adjudge that the said C. shall pay to the said Dan Capel the sum of twenty two pounds & twelve shillings for Damages sustained in his Timber by means of the said Canal and also for ~~the~~ Taxes paid by the said Dan Capel for the said Land taken by the Company.

And we also adjudge and determine that the said Dan Capel his heirs & assigns shall have a right of ~~the~~ ^{How and foot} Carriage Way, as the same has been usually enjoyed by the said Dan Capel over and through that part of the said Mead called Mansoles Mead purchased by the said C. and lying near Walbridge Wharf -
